

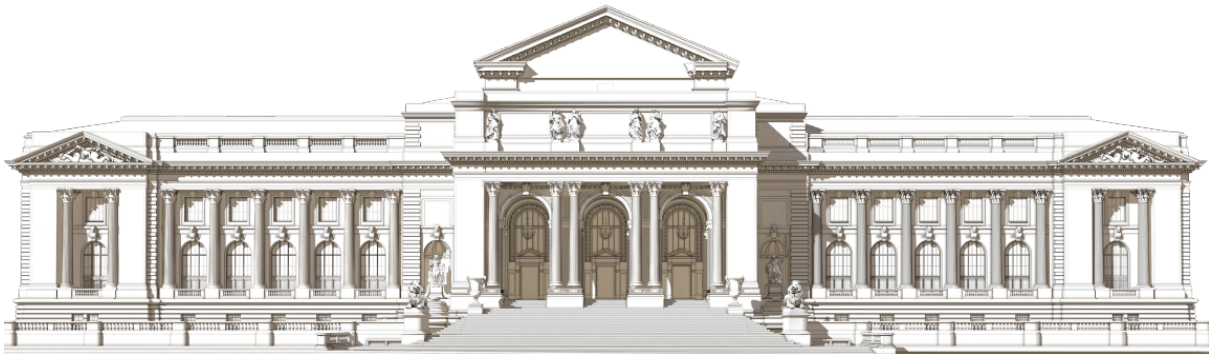

The New York Public Library houses 53 million items. It is the second largest library in the United States, and the fourth largest in the world! We will visit the flagship location, the Stephen A Schwarzman Building, with its majestic Beaux-Arts entrance, home to the renowned pair of marble lion statues, Patience and Fortitude. Our docent-led tour will highlight the history, architecture, and collections of this magnificent building, including a visit to the Rose Main Reading Room.

The New York Public Library has partnered with iconic bakery Amy's Bread to bring visitors a spectacular new café location on the seventh floor of the newly renovated Stavros Niarchos Foundation Library (SNFL). *The adjacent library building can be accessed without going outside (in case of inclement weather)*

With the only free, publicly accessible rooftop terrace in Midtown, the new café offers patrons a simple lunch while enjoying the incredible view of the library's historic Stephen A. Schwarzman Building and up and down Fifth Avenue.
