



## ON MAY 21<sup>ST</sup>, THE FRIENDS RETURN TO MOMA, OUR THIRD VISIT THERE

The Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in New York City is unequivocally the world's preeminent institution dedicated to collecting, preserving, and displaying modern and contemporary art.

This spring, MoMA will stage the first **Marcel Duchamp** retrospective the US has seen in fifty years. The show will include 300 of his works spanning six decades of Duchamp's "gleefully subversive" career. The exhibition includes his pre-revolutionary salon paintings (from when the artist still played by the rules), notably *Nude Descending a Staircase*, one of the most famous paintings in American history.

Art's most elegant troublemaker, Duchamp is then associated with Cubist, Dada, and Surrealism art, and is known for his "Readymades". One of the most influential artists of the 20th century, his work was a precursor for Conceptual Art.

We will tour this exhibition with outstanding educators from the museum, who will answer your questions such as "What makes this art?"

## DETAILS
