The High Line is a unique public park in Manhattan, built on a historic, elevated freight rail line that runs about 1.5 miles, from the Meatpacking District to Hudson Yards, with stunning Hudson River views and architectural viewpoints like the 10th Avenue Square amphitheater.

Our professional tour guides will share the park's history, design, and landscape as we stroll, highlighting the unique sculptures, murals, and public art installations that make this elevated park a living outdoor gallery.

Afterwards, you may shop and have lunch in Chelsea Market, or you may choose to visit the Whitney Museum on your own. You will have two independent hours to explore and enjoy.
